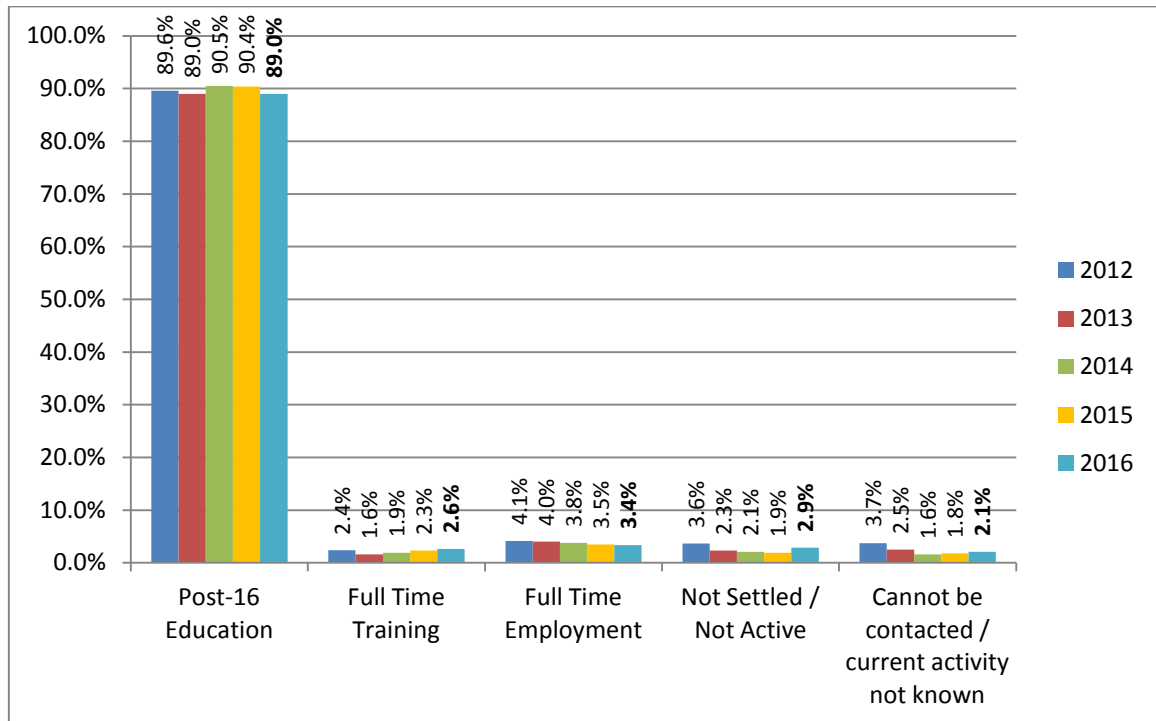


Year 11 Destination Trends 2012-2016 (February 2017)

The chart below shows the activity status of the Year 11 cohorts from 2012 to 2016:



- 89.0% of leavers moved into some form of education. This however has fallen to the lowest percentage in the past five years.
- The percentage of school leavers moving into full-time training increased in 2016 to 2.6% from 2.3% in 2015; with a slight decrease of school leavers moving into an employment status (3.4% from 3.5%).
- The number of leavers in a not settled / not active destination increased in 2016 by 1%, a number increase of 35, mostly due to an increase of leavers recorded as NEET.
- The number of not known / cannot be contacted young people in 2016 saw an increase of 0.3% to 2.1%, but this is significantly lower than the 2012 rate of 3.7%.
